TEACHING YOUR CHILD TO SELF-ADVOCATE

Children with Heterotaxy are incredible warriors who often face stressful medical situations. Helping them to understand that they have choices during their time in the hospital can minimize their anxiety and fears. Learning to self-advocate early on will pay off immensely throughout their lives.
